



Balboa Residential Parking Permit Program Advisory Ballot

A resident parking zone is proposed for all public streets between Island Avenue and Adams Street, except for on-street metered stalls at the median in Balboa Boulevard. Refer to the map on the back of the enclosed letter. Phase 1 (Medina Way to Adams St.) would be implemented first. Phase 2 (Island Ave. to Medina Way) would be implemented after the successful implementation of Phase 1, if deemed necessary.

RP3 Requirements and Details

- All residents, with proof of residency, and Mooring Area C permit holders would be eligible.
- Four (4) permanent permits per household and six (6) overnight guest permits per day.
- \$16 per annual permit each year, \$1 per guest for each overnight period.
- On-street parking restricted to valid permit holders between 4 p.m. – 9 a.m., 7 days per week, excluding federal holidays.
- No parking preference (no guaranteed parking spaces).
- Permits are non-transferable and have no monetary value.
- Parking for more than 72 consecutive hours is prohibited.
- Non-transferable parking permits would be issued annually and may include a sticker affixed to a resident's vehicle; a rearview mirror hangtag; or linked to a vehicle's license plate number. The type of permit display is to be determined.
- The City may reserve one or two spaces at street ends to preserve public access to the Bay and Ocean.
- The program outlined in this advisory ballot, if adopted by the City, is subject to change.
